An integrated dishwasher doesn't go in a cupboard but will sit between 2 cupboards and has a matching door. It should work OK where a freestanding one is but you might find you need to buy a cheap door to put on it as without it the weight won't feel right and it may not open and close easily.

Please could somebody tell me how a fully integrated fridge freezer should be fitted? The cupboard is a standard B& Q 1880mm high, and the ff is only 1770 high, yet has brackets on the top indicating that it should be fixed to the top of the cupboard. Do i need to elevate the fridge freezer or ignore the top fixing brackets?

There is much less choice of integrated appliances and they cost more than the same specification of non-integrated appliances. The integration also tends to make access for cleaning the washing machine filter more difficult, but I have now changed the plinth so that the section in front of the washing machine is now attached with magnetic catches rather than ...

The problem is, our existing fridge is now dying, but it is probably at least a year until we are ready to do the new kitchen. Cut a hole through the back of the cupboard, and fit a surface-mount box to the wall behind.
