No. Solar panels don't need direct sunlight to harness energy from sun, they just require some level of daylight in order to generate electricity. That said, the rate at which solar panels generate electricity varies depending on the amount of direct sunlight and the quality, ...

The first part is the power optimizer, which handles DC to DC and optimizes or conditions the solar panel's power.
