Where is Dongsha marine park located?

The marine park is located at Pratas Island (Dongsha Island) in the north of the South China Sea, and includes the Dongsha Atoll (Pratas Atoll), a circular atoll 25 kilometres (16 mi) in diameter with a tropical monsoon climate, and the surrounding seas.

Who owns Dongsha Island?

In 2007, the Dongsha Atoll National Park was established on the island. The People's Republic of China claims the island, atoll and banks as part of Guangdong Province.

What is the location of Dongsha Airport?

How big is Dongsha Island?

The atoll is approximately 23 km in diameter and covers an area of more than 460 km. The only small (1.74 km) Dongsha Island is built of coral debris in the west of the atoll. A post of the R.O.C. coast guard and the Dongsha Atoll National Park (DANP) headquarters (since 2007) are maintained on this island on a regular basis.
