What size locker space do I Need?

Having the right size locker space is crucial for stashing all your stuff neatly. Most normal lockers are about 72 inches high. But if you've got some tall students or grownup employees over 6 feet, you'll wanna get lockers that are more like 78 or even 84 inches high.

How wide should a locker be?

For width, lockers often come in 12, 15, or 18 inches wide. Then there's locker depth - that's how deep front to back they are inside. Locker depths usually range from 12 inches to 24 inches deep.

How big should a locker room be?
