Is it illegal to install solar panels on a residential property?

A do-it-yourself solar panel installation is not illegal. You'll typically not need planning permission to install solar panels on the roof of your residential property. You'll need permission to install solar panels on a listed property or a conservation area.

Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.
