No. You'll not have any tax obligation for a DIY solar panel installation on your residential property. In April 2022, the UK government introduced a zero-rate VAT on installing energy-saving materials like solar panels in residential accommodations to encourage households to adopt renewable energy sources.

Can solar panels be installed on a listed home?

To install solar panels on a listed home, you must apply for a Listed Building Consent (LBC) from the LPA.
