A solar panel installer, also known as a photovoltaic (PV) installer, is a professional responsible for the installation and maintenance of solar energy systems. Suppose, in our case the load is 3000 Wh/per day. To know the needed total W Peak of a solar panel capacity, we use PFG factor i.e. Total W Peak of PV panel capacity = $3000 / 3.2$ (PFG) = 931 W Peak. Now, the required number of PV panels are = $931 / 160W = 5.8$. This way, we need 6 numbers of solar panels each rated for 160W.
