



# Photovoltaic panel electricity

Efficiency is a measure of how much of the sun's potential energy a panel will convert into solar power. Most panels have an efficiency rating of between 15-23%.

Under typical UK conditions, 1m<sup>2</sup> of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so even under UK conditions a PV panel will generate many times more energy than was needed to manufacture it.
