If you reside in an area that receives 5 hours of maximum sunlight and your solar panel has a rating of 200 watts, the output of your solar panel can be calculated as follows: Daily watt hours = 5 \times 200 \times 0.75 = ...

To produce 1,000kWh per month, you would need a large solar panel system of at least 12kW or more which is likely to require 16+ panels. It should be noted, however, that the average home only uses 2,700kWh per year, which would only require 4-5kW (approx. 10 panels).

Most home panels can each produce between 250 and 400 Watts per hour. According to the Renewable Energy Hub, domestic solar panel systems usually range in size from around 1 kW to 5 kW. Allowing for some cloudier days, and some lost power, a 5 kW system can generally produce around 4,500 kWh per year.
