Are there any micro-grid demonstrations built in China?

There are several micro-grid demonstrations built in China for research and/or power supply for rural areas or islands. To introduce the effect and progresses of China on micro-grids, the available micro-grids are comprehensive reviewed in the following section.

When was the State Grid Corporation of China founded?

The State Grid Corporation of China was founded on December 29, 2002, when the restructuring divided the former State Power Corporation of China into two grid companies, five generation groups and four accessorial business companies.

What is Xinao Energy Company's micro-grid demonstration?

Another micro-grid demonstration designed by CEPRI and built by Xinao Energy Company is the micro-grid in Langfang, Hebei, which is an important part of the eco-city of Xinao in Langfang. It was established in 2011 to exhibit the products of the company on biomass energy, wind/solar hybrid power generation, and micro-grid.

Who owns State Grid?

As of March 2024, State Grid is the world's third largest company overall by revenue, behind Walmart and Amazon. In 2023 it was reported as having 1.3 million employees, 1.1 billion customers and revenue equivalent to US\$546 billion. It is overseen by the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council.

Is there a micro-grid demonstration in Tianjin University?

There is a micro-grid demonstration in Tianjin University, as shown in Fig. 11. What happened to SGCC's North China Grid Company?

When the SGCC management adopted a pilot change by bringing two municipal power companies in Beijing and Tianjin under its umbrella as one direct subsidiary in late 2008, it in effect hollowed out the North China Grid Company.
