What is a digital microfilm file?

Digital microfilm files are much larger in size than the rest of our digital content (files contain up to 800 pages) and so is only available to online users with a broadband connection. Computers with limited memory may struggle to open them and it will almost certainly take your computer some time to download each file.

How do I report a digitized microfilm publication?

Original records that have been digitized for which there is no microfilm will have "Original records" listed in the microfilm publication number column.
