What is solar farm development in Wales?

Solar farm development in Wales- the latest figures. Solar farms, or solar parks, are the large-scale application of Solar Photovoltaic (PV) installations used to generate electricity which is fed into the local electricity grid. They often cover large areas of land (between 1 and 100 acres) and therefore are normally developed in rural locations.

Could a solar farm be on Anglesey?

Plans for a solar farm on Anglesey, which faced local opposition, have been approved by the Welsh government. The development will cover around 150 acres (61 hectares) of land near the villages of Bryngwran and Caergeiliog. Developers claim it could produce the electricity to power 11,630 homes a year, saving 7,161 tonnes of CO₂.

Are solar farms a good idea for Wales?

The developers behind these solar farms they are against - and there are many - would argue that their aim is to create clean; green and renewable energy which we need more of in Wales. Others argue that offshore wind or tidal energy is a more suitable way to reach our goals on renewables.

Could wind & solar farms industrialise the Welsh countryside?

More wind and solar farms would industrialise the Welsh countryside and affect about 50,000 acres of land, according to a rural charity. Offshore wind and rooftop solar should be the preferred way to cut carbon emissions, says the Campaign for the Protection of Rural Wales (CPRW).

Does the Welsh Government really care about solar development?

Planning Secretary Rebecca Evans said the Welsh Government takes into consideration "the opportunities and the impacts proposed by solar developments". She said ambition to meet climate targets "doesn't mean we are going to abandon policies for the protection of our most valuable environments".

Project Overview. As the development capacity will be more than 10MW, it is defined as a Development of National Significance (DNS). This means that the planning application will be submitted to the Planning and Environment Decisions Wales (PEDW) and considered by an Inspector with the final decision made by Welsh Ministers.

The project has already received council backing but required Welsh Government assent because the size of the solar farm means it is considered to be a "development of national significance".
